

Context for National Resilience Programme (NRP)

Becoming eligible for graduation from LDC, Bangladesh has taken it's status to a new height. The country earned global reputation in many areas of MDGs and currently development agenda is highly focused in achieving SDGs. In spite of all glorious success, Bangladesh economy is at risk of growing loss and damages due to disaster and climate stresses. Between 1970 and 2013, the country reported over USD 180.3 million in economic losses from natural disasters. Considering the significant linkage between disasters and development, 7th Five Year Plan of the Government of Bangladesh emphasized on a sustainable development pathway that is resilient to disaster and climate change.

Under above context, National Resilience Programme (NRP) has been formulated

for 36 months. The NRP formally launched on 14 November 2018 and will continue till March 2021.

Resilience is the ability of men and women, households, communities, cities, institutions and societies to respond positively, efficiently and effectively when faced with shocks and stress, while maintaining an acceptable level of functioning and without compromising long-term prospects for sustainable development, peace and security, human

NRP is funded

by Swedish International Development Cooperation Agency (Sida) and Department for International Development (DFID), UK. This programme has technical partnership with UNDP, UN-Women and UNOPS and implementing partnership with four GoB agencies.

The goal of the NRP is to sustain the resilience of human and economic development in Bangladesh through inclusive, gender responsive disaster management and risk informed development.
